Registered Nurse Job Description

The following duties may fall under the scope of practice of the Registered Nurse Consultant:

- Interview a client and document the client's pertinent history for screening purposes.
- Assess and document the client's physical health, mental health, and environmental safety.
- Assess the client's pharmaceutical regimen.
- Record and report the results of the nursing assessment.
- Collaborate with other healthcare providers in determining the appropriate health care for the client.
- Record and report nursing care given to the client.
- Plan and deliver appropriate nursing acts for which the RN has received formal training and has had competency validation.
- Prepare an appropriate Plan of Care and review it with the client.
- Evaluate the outcomes/client responses to teaching and nursing care, if any.
- Teach the client to implement his/her personalized treatment regimen whether from the medical doctor or other allied healthcare professional.
- Assist the client to properly implement his/her pharmaceutical regimen as prescribed by a lawfully authorized person.
- Provide teaching and counseling about the client's health.
- Provide family training for common nursing procedures.
- Teach group healthcare classes following an established guideline.
- Act as a client advocate.
- Assist client in completing medical/insurance forms.
- Delegate and/or supervise other personnel in implementing the client's treatment regimen.
- Perform competency validations for other RNs, LPNs, or other healthcare personnel.
- Participate in annual skills training.
- Participate in annual competency validation.
- Perform other assigned duties within the scope of RN practice as deemed necessary.
